Old Business

The show program- Peg said its coming along. We still need to get some ads in. Brenda has some ads and Carla was going to try for a few more. Stan said he could do the program for less than \$10.00 a page and could have the program back to us fairly quickly.

Easter candy- Jane can't find last year's order form to know exactly what we bought, but we will get a mix of milk and dark 200 pieces and figure out how to distribute them to be sold.

Peg said she would look into the flower/plant fund raiser for either Easter or Mother's Day.

We will change the wording in the program to state that "spurs, bats an crops are optional" We have the option to censure or eject anyone using these items in an abusive manner.

New Business:
