The meeting was called to order at 7:10PM.

### **Old Business:**

### **New Business:**

1. There was some discussion and agreement amongst the present members that the June show will be a one day affair. The dates for the show season this year are: **June 10<sup>th</sup>, July 8<sup>th</sup>, September 9<sup>th</sup> and October 7<sup>th</sup>** Jenny Lang made a motion to accept the dates, seconded by Roberta Jackson and carried unanimously.
2. June 23<sup>rd</sup> is the weekend that the “Dakota 9” would need the show grounds as a stop over on their horse trek to NYC. This was to occur last year but there was a change of plans with the group. Again they would be willing to do a presentation and we could ask for donation and use the event as a fund raiser for the club.

3. Nancy Locke presented a class list for the June, July and September show. It is attached with the minutes. The class list combines some of classes to make the show more practical and competitive. After much discussion it was decided not to combine the trail classes since the trail class usually has its own judge and runs concurrently with the ring classes. The attached list does not reflect the separation of the trail classes.

A Motion was made to leave the October show class list the same as in the past by Nancy Locke and seconded by Debbie Oakley. The motion was carried unanimously.

Randy Ostrander Jr will find sponsors for the High Point Award for all shows.

4. The web site needs to be updated. Jane will forward me Frank Baker's email so minutes can be added to the site.

5. There was some discussion concerning the 2012 program book. In the past it has always paid for itself through ads and support. April Richers will do some investigation concerning the program.

6. In February, we need to look at the class cost and considering raising the fee.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:40PM. The next meeting will be February 20, 2012 at 7:00pm at the Family Dinner.
