# Directions to WRC Show Grounds

16 Broadview Road, Woodstock, NY 12498

## FROM THE SOUTH

Take NYS Thruway Exit 19, Kingston. Bear right onto traffic circle and take 1st right onto Rt. 28 West. Travel 6 miles West to the intersection of Rt. 375. turn right onto Rt. 375. Travel 2.8 miles; watch for golf course on right and school on left. Turn left onto Millstream Road (before bridge and Rt. 212). Go to stop sign and bear left. Travel approximately .5 mile and turn right onto Broadview Road. WRC driveway on right, .2 mile.

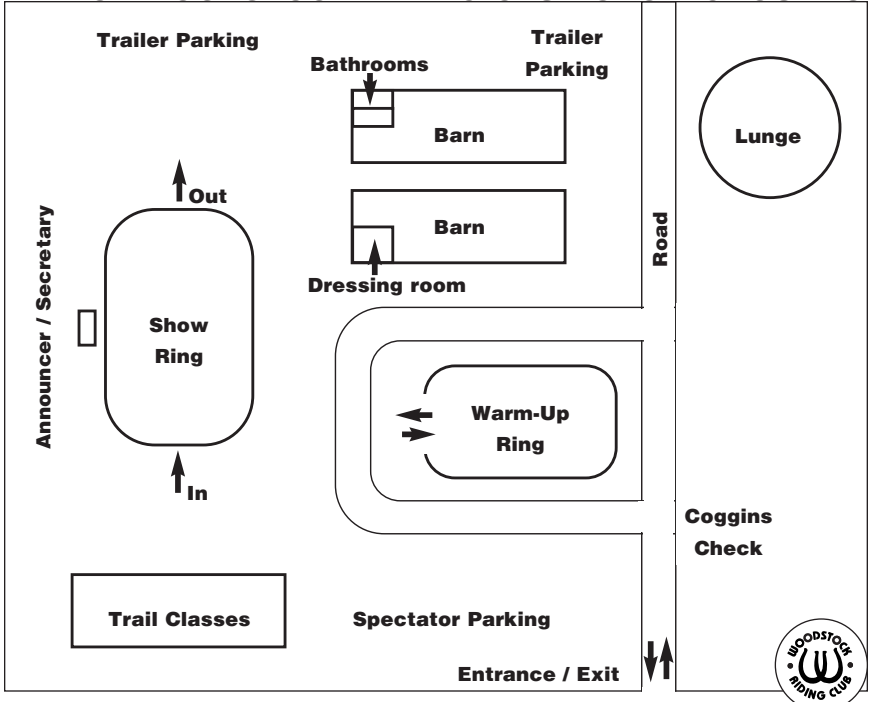
## FROM THE EAST (East of the Hudson River)

Take Rhinecliff Bridge to Rt. 199 to Rt. 209. Take Rt. 209 to Rt. 28 West. Follow the above.

## FROM THE NORTH

NYS Thruway to Exit 20, Saugerties. Turn left after toll, onto Rt. 32 South. At light turn right onto Rt. 212 (to Woodstock). Travel 10 miles to intersection of Rt. 375/212; just before village of Woodstock. Turn left onto 375, go slow! Cross bridge and immediately turn right onto Millstream Road. Go to stop sign, bear left. Travel approximately .5 mile, then turn right onto Broadview Road. WRC driveway is on right, .2 mile.

# General Rules and Information

• Due to insurance regulations **MINOR RIDERS** must have a signed liability waiver upon entry to the show grounds. TRAINERS AND COACHES **MAY NOT SIGN THE WAIVER**. The signature **MUST** be that of a parent or legal guardian. Please plan accordingly.

• All riders/exhibitors 18 years and under must wear properly fitting protective headgear which passes or surpasses ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. The harness must be secured and helmet must be properly fitted; this includes in hand classes. All riders in all classes where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds must wear protective headgear. Any rider/exhibitor violating this rule at any time will immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) in any division or class without penalty from the judge. The Woodstock Riding Club strongly encourages all riders, while riding anywhere on the club grounds, to wear protective headgear with harness secured which passes or surpasses ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It is the responsibility of the rider, parent or guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards for protective headgear intended for equestrian use and is properly fitted and in good condition. The Woodstock Riding Club makes no representation or warranty, express or implied, about any protective headgear, and cautions riders that death or serious injury may result despite wearing such headgear as all equestrian sports involve inherent dangerous risk and as no helmet can protect against all foreseeable injuries.

- All shows will start promptly: June 2, July 14, September 8 at 8AM, and October 6 at 9AM
- Registration for western classes start at 11am. Western classes will not start before 12pm.
- Alcohol is prohibited on show grounds. Anyone drinking or intoxicated will be asked to leave the grounds. Failure to cooperate may result in forfeit of points and further showing.
- Schooling is allowed in designated areas only. Lunging in the lunge area only. There will be **NO** trotting or cantering outside of the rings.
- Trail: MOUNTED schooling over the trail course is not permitted however the course may be walked, on foot, without a horse, as time allows.
- For safety, all dogs and other pets must be confined or on a leash. Motor bikes and bicycles must be walked (motors shut off) when on show grounds.
- No horses to be turned out in either ring, at anytime.
- Junior horses 5 years and under may be shown in a western under saddle class in a snaffle bit or bosal ridden with two hands. Bits must conform to rules of the USA Equestrian Federation (Formerly A.H.S.A.). If this option is taken, it must be consistent in all classes. No mechanical hackamores are permitted.
- Spurs, crops or bats are optional.



## General Rules and Information continued

- **A current coggins and/or GO pass and Rabies certificate (within 12 months prior to the show) must be on file at the secretary's stand. WRC strongly encourages exhibitors to follow the USEF guidelines for vaccinations especially EH 1/4. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- Entry fees are \$12.00 per class unless otherwise noted. Payment is due at the time of entry by cash or check. Signed blank checks are acceptable to add on classes. There is a \$10.00 charge for accounts not settled by the end of the day and a \$25.00 charge for returned checks. Signed blank checks will be accepted as an "open check" for the purpose of adding classes only. Scratched classes will still be charged.
- Entries are made on a one horse/rider/handler combination.
- Riders wearing the wrong number will forfeit points. No number results in elimination.
- Horses will be lined up on the rail as the previous class is being pinned. You must have your horses ready. We cannot hold up any class without prior notice of a tack change.
- Cross entering is encouraged, so please plan accordingly and notify the secretary's stand of tack changes ahead of time.
- Walk/trot and walk/jog classes, including the Adult Division, are for exhibitors who have not shown at the canter or lope prior to the show date. Entries in walk/trot or walk/jog classes may not show in any other division on the day of the show.
- Adult walk/trot/jog is based on the rider's eligibility, not the horse's.
- Adult Walk/ Trot/ Jog Division is for riders 14 and over as of 1/1/24 who are not able to canter or lope.
- All harnessed horse/pony drivers under 14 must wear a helmet and be accompanied by a person 18 or older in the vehicle.
- The show committee reserves the right to cancel/combine/split classes as deemed necessary and safe. If there are less than 4 entries in a class, it may be combined appropriately.
- Trail course will be open for English riders from 9:30am-12:30pm and for Western riders from 1pm-3:30pm with the exception of the October show. The Trail course will be open to English riders from 10am-12:30pm and Western riders until 3:30pm. Courtesy to English riders should be given before 12:30pm.
- Leadline (all seats) will be held around 11am in the June, July, and September shows, and around noon in the October Show. Leadliners MUST be led, on a leadline, by a person 16 years of age or older, with appropriate footwear.
- WRC follows the US Equestrian Federation rules very closely.
- **Judge's decision is final.**

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# Barn Rules

- A fire lane **MUST** be left open, between the barns and all the way out to the access point of the driveway. Please be mindful of this when parking behind the barns.
- At no time may animals be left unsupervised on WRC grounds.
- All juniors must have senior member supervision for all overnight stays.
- Limited stabling is available. Reservations are recommended, please contact Ralph Vankleek at vrmello1985@aol.com or 845-464-4240
- Stall reservations require payment at time of reservation.
- Please call Ralph Vankleek by the Monday prior to the show if you are not using your season stall. It is the stall renters responsibility to notify the barn manager if the stalls are not going to be used.
- No stalls shall be used as tack rooms. Stalls are open to equines only.
- Members may not sublet stalls.
- Stall fees: \$15/members, \$20/non-members for day of show, \$5.00 additional for overnight. (arriving day prior to show). Seasonal stalls are \$60 for members, \$70 for non-members.
- 2 Seasonal stalls will be available to paid members after January 1 of the current year. After April 1, if any stalls remain, they will become available to non-members on a first come, first serve basis. Stalls must be cleaned after each use, if not charges may occur.
- Exhibitors must furnish their own supplies and care of mounts. At times shavings may be available for purchase. Call ahead for availability.
- No tying or cross tying horses to barn poles.
- R.V. electric hook up prohibited.
- All exhibitors/riders must have a signed “Disclaimer of Liability” on file at the secretary’s stand before entering their first class or riding on the club grounds.
- Anyone 18 and under riding, driving and/or showing a horse on the club grounds must wear an approved ASTM/SEI certified helmet. This includes all in hand classes. See general rules for more information.
- All riders, regardless of age, must wear an ASTM/SEI approved helmet when schooling or showing over jumps. See general rules for more information.



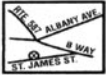


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# How Classes are to be Judged

## **MODEL**

To be judged on the confirmation of the horse or pony. To be shown in appropriate tack for your discipline.

## **FITTING AND SHOWMANSHIP**

To be shown in a suitable halter (western) or bridle (English), judged on neatness and showmanship of handler and cleanliness of horse and tack.

## **WALK/TROT, WALK/JOG, & ADULT WALK/TROT/JOG EQUITATION AND PLEASURE**

To be shown both ways of the ring at the walk and trot or jog. To be judged on seat, hands, and control of the horse or pony at the requested gaits. May be asked to perform a pattern and to back their horse or pony.

## **EQUITATION/HORSEMANSHIP**

To be shown at a walk, trot/jog and canter/lope, both ways of the ring, to perform at the discretion of the judge to be judged on seat, hands and the control of the horse at the requested gaits. May be asked to perform a pattern.

## **PLEASURE**

To be shown at a walk, trot/jog and canter/lope both ways of the ring, to be judged on performance, manners, and the ability to give a pleasurable ride.

## **ROAD HACK**

To be shown both ways of the ring, at a walk, trot/jog, and canter/lope in novice and open classes. Extension of gaits, halt and back can be asked at judges discretion.

## **EQUITATION OVER FENCES**

To be shown over 8 - 10 fences, course to be posted. To be judged on seat, hands, and control of the horse.

## **HUNTER OVER FENCES**

To be shown over a course of 8 - 10 fences not to exceed 2'6" in height, judged on performance, soundness and suitability.

## **TRAIL**

Trail course will be open for English riders from 9:30am-12:30pm and for Western riders from 1pm-4pm with the exception of the October show. The Trail course will be open to English riders from 10am-12:30pm and Western riders until 3:30pm. Courtesy to English riders should be given before 12:30pm.

## **CROSSRAILS/GROUND POLES**

To be shown over a maximum of 8 fences not to exceed 18" high. Walk/trot riders must show at the trot.

## **HUNTER UNDER SADDLE**

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring, riders may be asked to hand gallop. Light contact with the horse's mouth required. Judged on performance, soundness and suitability.

## **GREEN HORSE**

Open to horses in their first or second year of showing at the canter or lope.

## **LEADLINE**

Open to exhibitors 8 years old and under. Horse and rider must be lead ON A LEADLINE, ATTACHED TO A HALTER, BY SOMEONE 16 YEARS OR OLDER, with appropriate footwear. May be asked to jog/trot and or turn their horses. May not exhibit in any other class except leadline trail.

## **PLEASURE DRIVING TURNOUT**

To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, slow trot and strong trot, to stand quietly and rein back. May be asked to execute a figure 8. To be judged 40% on performance, manners and way of going, 30% on condition, fit and appropriateness of harness and vehicle, 15% on appropriateness and neatness of attire, 15% on overall impression.

## **PLEASURE DRIVING REINSMANSHIP**

To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, slow trot, working and strong trot. To stand quietly and to rein back. May be asked to execute a figure 8 and perform any other appropriate tests. To be judged 75% on handling of reins and whip control, posture and overall appearance of driver, 25% on the condition of harness and vehicle, and neatness of attire.

# Class Awards Eligibility

**Walk / Trot / Jog Divisions** - Are for riders 13 years and under as of 1/1/24  
Riders CANNOT have shown at the canter or lope prior to this day

**Adult Walk / Trot / Jog Division** - Is for riders 14 and over as of 1/1/24 who  
are not able to canter/lope.

**Youth Hunter** - Open to all riders 18 & under as of 1/1/24. This is a  
walk/trot/canter division. Fences will not exceed 18 inches.

**Schooling Hunter** - Fences not to exceed 18 inches.

**Low Hunter** - Fences not to exceed 2 feet.

**Green** - Open to horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing.

**Novice** - Is based on riders eligibility - rider has not won 3 blue ribbons  
in each class.

**Open** - Is open to all riders.

**Driving** - Is open to all.

**\*\*\* Stallions may be entered in Green or Open, including Schooling,  
Low Hunter Divisions and must be shown by an exhibitor 18 years  
or older. Stallions are not permitted in any Walk/Trot/Jog or Novice  
classes.**

## DAY END ELIGIBILITY:

- Must show in majority of classes in the division.
- Entries are kept on a one horse, one rider/handler combination. Ties for the day or year end awards will be determined by placing received in Equitation class(es).
- Day end points are kept on a 6/5/4/3/2/1 basis.

## YEAR END ELIGIBILITY:

- **Must be a Woodstock Riding Club member**
- **All members must sign up for membership and year end awards prior to their first class for points to count toward year end awards.**
- **Must show in at least 2 of the 3 pointed shows: June 2, July 14, and Sept. 8**
- Year end points are kept on a 6/5/4/3/2/1 basis.
- Must show in majority of classes in the division

- 3. **Louise Van Wagonen - Horse and Rider of the Year:** Awarded to the horse and rider team with the highest number of points overall in Open Classes.
  
- 4. **Linda P. Every - Versatility:** Awarded to the exhibitor with the highest overall points in the combined open divisions. Exhibitor must enter 2 of the 3 disciplines to be eligible. Open English, Open Hunter and must include Open Western.
  
- 5. **Carol Hicks Perpetual Trophy:** Highest points overall in Open western division. Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded.
